Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
5	#28-335-25-03	15mm lampwork glass puffed coin beads, white
2	#28-333-55-15	14mm lampwork glass rondelle beads, peridot
2	#28-333-55-17	14mm lampwork glass rondelle beads, pink/amethyst
5	#05-328-06-16	SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS 6mm bicone crystal beads, rose
1	#37-091-10-3	1" thin ball-end head pin, silver plate
1	#39-190-12-3	12mm toggle clasp, silver plate
9 feet	#46-450-21	20-gauge silver-plated Artistic Wire®, non-tarnish silver

Tools and supplies:

Beadsmith® zebra stripe tool set (#69-291)
(use side cutters, round-nose pliers, chain-nose pliers, flat-nose pliers)

TIPS:

- The coiled links are inspired by the “Hook, Line and Sinker” project from Kerry Bogert’s *Totally Twisted: Innovative Wirework and Art Glass Jewelry* (#62-510).
- Cut thirty-six 3" pieces of wire.
- Create 24 coiled-wire links and 12 bead links with wrapped loops at each end. Wrap and connect the segments as you go in the pattern pictured.
- Overall length is approximately 19".
