

“Fleur Noir” Choker

Tools: 24-hour epoxy (#60-210), cutters (#65-500)

Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
5	#03-700-14-24	14mm Swarovski® crystal margarita beads, jet
6	#05-000-06-24	6mm Swarovski crystal faceted round crystal beads, jet
10	#49-947-52-AS	8mm TierraCast™ large-hole Bali-style spacer beads, antiqued silver
1	#52-090-20-9	Unfinished-end 1mm steel cable choker with magnetic clasp, black
10	#03-700-12-02	12mm Swarovski crystal margarita beads, crystal/aurora borealis

1. String beads as desired.
2. Cut cable to desired length.
3. Glue clasp end, and let cure for 24 hours.

Tips for this design:

When gluing more than one choker, glue each clasp end to the necklace that it came from. Don't mix up the ends, or you might end up with a polarity mismatch.
