Suggested Materials:

1	#20-465-L	Tibetan-style oval bead, Chinese turquoise
1	#20-616-081	6mm freshwater rice pearl, bronze

1	#39-157	Tiny toggle clasp, antiqued bronze
1	#49-954-04-AG	4mm flower spacer, antiqued gold
11	#37-123-9	Small oval jump ring, gunmetal
2	#37-136-9	Medium round jump rings, gunmetal
4	#37-415-9	1.5" thin head pins, gunmetal
4	#37-715-9	1.5" thin eye pins, gunmetal
1	#37-422-9	2" standard head pin, gunmetal
1	#86-343	3oz. bottle Win-Ox™ Miracle Oxidizer
18"	#40-099-16-6	2.1mm drawn flattened cable chain, antiqued brass
4	#05-301-06-137	6mm Swarovski® crystal faceted bicones, light olivine
2	#05-301-06-160	6mm Swarovski crystal faceted bicones, crystal/silver shade
4"	#40-099-17-6	2.9mm flat with figure-eight chain, antiqued brass (optional)

Tools: needle-nose pliers, flat-nose pliers, disposable plastic container, rubber gloves

To make this design:

1. Patina the filigrees by following the directions provided with your oxidizer.
2. One at a time, center the filigrees on the face of the turquoise bead, gently pressing the filigree edges to make the filigree conform to the shape of the bead. Line the filigree eyelets up on the sides and bottom.
3. String a 4mm flower spacer onto the 2" head pin and insert it from top to bottom through the turquoise bead, and then through the filigree eyelets at the base of the bead. Finish by wire wrapping a loop.
4. Attach a medium round jump ring to the filigree eyelets on one side.
(Optional: As you attach the jump ring, insert an end link of the 4" length of figure-eight chain onto the jump ring as it passes between the eyelets. Close the jump ring. Repeat on the other side.)
5. Make and attach the dangles:
 - a. Using standard wire-wrapping techniques, make two silver shadow and two light olivine crystal dangles on head pins and two pearl connectors on eye pins, all with wire-wrapped loops at the top.
 - b. Use the small oval jump rings to attach the dangles to the loop at the base of the filigree. The design can either be similar to the one pictured, or be of your own design.
6. Make and attach the chain:
 - a. Create a crystal connector using an eye pin and a light olivine bicone, and wire wrap a loop at the top. Repeat to make a second connector.
 - b. Cut the 18" of drawn flat cable chain into two 9" sections.
 - c. Use a small oval jump ring to connect a crystal connector to one side of the filigree pendant, and a second jump ring to connect the crystal link to the chain. Repeat for the other side of the necklace.
 - d. Use a small oval jump ring to connect the toggle portion of the clasp to one of the chain ends. Repeat on the other side with the ring portion of the clasp.
