

## “Barbed” Necklace

### Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	39-231-015	7x16mm barrel clasp, hematite
140	29-162	4-5mm heishi beads, violet oyster
13	21-382-015	8x12mm bamboo-shaped beads, hematite
26	21-703-015	3mm gemstone cube beads, hematite
2	41-251-9	Size 1 smooth crimp beads, gunmetal
18”	61-413-49-87	0.013” 49-strand Beadalon®, steel

**Tools:** Flat-nose pliers, cutters

### To make this design:

1. Slide one end of the magnetic clasp onto the Beadalon followed by a crimp bead.
2. Flatten the crimp bead about ½” from the end of the Beadalon, cut excess and pull wire tight into the clasp to hide the crimp.
3. String beads in the following pattern: 10 oyster heishi, 1 hematite cube, 1 hematite bamboo-shaped, 1 hematite cube
4. Repeat the pattern 13 times.
5. String ten more oyster heishi, followed by the other end of the magnetic clasp and a crimp bead.
6. Pull the necklace tight and flatten the crimp bead as close to the clasp end as possible.
7. Trim excess wire and allow crimp bead to drop into the clasp where it will be hidden.
