

# “Caramel Cubes” Necklace

**Tools:**  
Crimping pliers

### Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
One	#52-490-1	18" one-strand cable choker, sterling silver
Ten	#24-998-04	Gold-filled SmartBeads™
Four	#21-708-031	Gemstone cubes, tigereye
One	#21-000-031-69	Gemstone marquise bead, tigereye

### To make this design:

1. Begin on the open side of your cable choker. Add beads in the following order: One SmartBead, one gemstone cube, two SmartBeads, one cube, two SmartBeads, one marquise bead, two SmartBeads, one cube, two SmartBeads, one cube, and one final smart bead.
2. Using the “gripping” design of the SmartBeads, arrange your bead sections approx. 2” apart, making sure that your marquise gemstone rests nicely in the center of the necklace. A bead section consists of one gemstone, and two SmartBeads on either end of the gemstone.
3. Slide open cable-end into the clasp tube and crimp closed. For added security, add a drop of glue before attaching the clasp end.

TIP: SmartBeads have a Bead Positioning System (BPS™) that allows them to stay stationary wherever you place them, without losing the design flexibility of a crimp bead. SmartBeads can be moved along your cord as many times as you wish, without losing their ability to grip the cord.
