Suggested Materials

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock#</u>	<u>Name</u>
9	20-465-L	Tibetan-style Chinese turquoise ovals
3	20-599-02	Ax-shaped apple coral pendants
2	41-256-02-3	Size 2 crimp tubes, silver plated
20	24-731-739	Bali sterling corrugated rondelles
8	20-580-6	Round black bamboo coral beads, 6mm
1	39-550-Q	Twisted-oval toggle clasp, sterling
20"	61-720-49-87	49-strand Beadalon® stringing cable

Tools: cutters, chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Cut approximately 20" of Beadalon. (The finished length is 18".)
2. String the Beadalon through one crimp tube and one side of toggle clasp.
3. Use chain-nose pliers to flatten and secure the crimp tube.
4. String beads in order shown in picture: black coral, corrugated rondelles, oval Chinese turquoise and the ax-shaped apple coral pendants.
5. String the second crimp tube and other part of toggle clasp onto the Beadalon.
6. Slide extra Beadalon back through the crimp tube and several end beads.
7. Use chain-nose pliers to flatten and secure the crimp tube.

TIP: When making necklaces with very heavy stones, you can get a more secure piece by using a toggle clasp. Daintier clasps such as spring ring clasps can break with the weight.
