- #44-507 Sailboat charm, sterling silver
- #44-500 Dolphin charm, sterling silver
- #44-503 Starfish charm, sterling silver
- #44-505 Anchor charm, sterling silver
- #49-715 Life preserver charm, sterling silver
- #37-245 3.3mm round jump rings, sterling silver



Cinderella Charm Pin

- #38-162 Bow-shaped holder pin, sterling silver
- #49-565 Cinderella carriage charm, sterling silver
- #44-050-49 Heart charm, sterling silver
- #44-050-37 High-heel shoe charm, sterling silver
- #37-245 3.3mm round jump rings, sterling silver



Fruit Charm Pin

Tools: flat-nose pliers and chain-nose pliers

To make these designs:

1. Select a charm holder pin.
2. Select pleasing charms in a coordinating theme.
3. Attach the charms to the holder pin using jump rings.
4. Vary the length of the charms by varying the number of jump rings.
