Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
4	41-870-12-AS	12mm rivoli settings with 2 loops, antiqued silver
4	41-870-14-AS	14mm rivoli settings with 2 loops, antiqued silver
4	01-122-12-06	12mm Swarovski® round foil-back crystal rivoli stones, crystal/vitrail medium
4	01-122-14-06	14mm Swarovski® round foil-back crystal rivoli stones, crystal/vitrail medium
1	39-418-1	7x12mm magnetic clasp, white
2"	40-099-19-1	4.6mm drawn cable chain, white
1	60-230	Epoxy 330

Tools: flat-nose pliers, chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Connect the settings and magnetic clasp to form a bracelet using individual links of the drawn cable chain. Round or oval jump rings can alternately be used as links.
2. Mix the 2-part epoxy according to manufacturer's directions.
3. Add a moderate dollop to the back of each rivoli stone.
4. As you set the stone into the setting, the glue will fill the setting.
5. Allow the adhesive to thoroughly dry.



TIPS:

- Do not add too much 2-part epoxy or it will ooze beyond the edge and require clean up.
- To stabilize your bracelet, temporarily tie a string to the bracelet's first and last loop, then tape the strings to a piece of cardboard while pulling your bracelet tight. The settings should be facing up.
- To adjust the length of this bracelet, either vary the pattern of links and rivoli settings, or add an adjuster chain to the end of the bracelet.
- For a more secure bracelet, make a safety chain by attaching a 3" length of chain to the two jump rings on each side of the magnetic clasp.

NOTE: The white plating of the footage chain matches well with the antiqued-silver finish of the rivoli settings.
