

“Galileo’s Garden” Earrings

As seen in the 2007 Summer Supplement



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Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
2	#42-651-72-2	Marquise wire connectors, gold filled
2	#34-633	French hook ear wires, gold filled
2	#23-397-172	Czech glass flower bead caps, rose
4	#26-622	2mm round beads, gold filled
4	#24-999-25	2.5mm round beads, gold filled
2	#37-612	Head pins, gold filled
2	#37-390-13	Round jump rings, gold filled
2	#23-505-632	Czech glass flower spacer beads, blue zircon
2	#21-884-036	4mm round gemstone beads, rock crystal quartz

Tools needed: Chain-nose pliers, round-nose pliers, side cutters

To make this design:

- Place the following beads on a head pin to create a flower dangle:
 - One 2.5mm round gold-filled bead
 - One 2mm round gold-filled bead
 - One flower bead cap
 - One flower spacer bead
 - One 4mm round rock crystal quartz bead
 - One 2.5mm round gold-filled bead
 - One 2mm round gold-filled bead
- Use standard wire-wrapping technique (shown below) to create a loop on the top of the dangle.



- Use a jump ring to connect the flower dangle to the inside loop of the marquise-shaped connector.
- Open the loop on the French hook ear wire and insert the top loop on the marquise-shaped connector. Close the ear wire loop.
- Repeat steps 1-4 to make the second earring.
