Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
8	#37-136-3	Jump ring, silver plated
4 feet	#40-099-08-3	Curb chain, silver plated
2	#34-563	French hook ear wires, sterling silver
2	#06-090-22-09	22mm Swarovski® crystal baroque pendants, light amethyst
4	#06-090-16-09	16mm Swarovski crystal baroque pendants, light amethyst

Tools: Heavy-duty round-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Start by creating eight sections of chain, each a different length. The longest section of chain shown is just over 3" and the shortest is just under 1" long. We liked each chain section at roughly a ½" difference in length.

Note: for your second earring, you will want a matching set of eight sections. Creating all 16 at the same time is the easiest method. Once you're done, put one set aside for the second earring.

2. Using a jump ring, attach the largest baroque pendant to any of the medium length chains.
3. In the same fashion, add two of the smaller pendants to two of the shortest chains.
4. Finally, add each chain to the ring on the ear wire, in any order you choose, or in the order shown.
5. Repeat steps 2-5 for the second earring.

Tip: You can also use pre-made tassels such as #43-390, #43-391 or #43-392 for designs like this.
