Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
14"	40-099-03-7	5mm hammered long-and-short curb chain, antiqued copper
15"	40-099-13-0	2.1mm cable chain, raw brass
5	20-642-01-096	12mm freshwater coin-shaped pearls, champagne
5	20-642-01-091	12mm freshwater coin-shaped pearls, chocolate
4	37-136-7	5mm round jump rings, antiqued copper
10	37-722-7	2" standard eye pins, antiqued copper
1	39-850-00	Teardrop toggle clasp, copper

Tools: round-nose pliers, flush cutters

To make this design:

1. Cut two 7" pieces of cable chain and two 7 ½" pieces of hammered long-and-short curb chain.
2. Weave each piece of cable chain through the large links of the hammered chain.
3. Add a pearl to each of the 10 eye pins and make simple loops.
4. Attach the pearl connectors to the hammered long-and-short curb chain, as pictured.
5. Use a jump ring to connect the chain ends on each side, and to the toggle clasp.

To make nice loops on head or eye pins:

1. String selected beads on the head or eye pin.
2. Keep about 8mm (1/3") of wire. Cut off any extra.
3. Use round-nose pliers to grasp the wire just above the bead, at the arrow, and bend sharply away from you.
4. Now use small round-nose pliers to grasp the tip of the wire, and bend it smoothly around the pliers down close to the beads.
