## "Great Lengths" Mocca Rose Necklace

## Suggested Materials:

| 12 | $05-000-06-169$ | 6mm faceted round Swarovski® crystal beads, vintage rose |
| 12 | $05-000-06-179$ | 6mm faceted round Swarovski crystal beads, mocca |
| 24 | $37-715-6$ | 1.5" thin eye pins, antiqued brass <br> $28^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $40-099-01-6$ | 4.2 mm curb chain, antiqued brass |  |

Tools: round-nose pliers, cutters, flat-nose pliers

## To make this design:

1. Cut 24 two-inch lengths of chain.
2. Add the crystals to the eye pins and make loops.
3. With chain-nose pliers, attach the crystal eye pins to the chain lengths, alternating the crystal colors as you go.

## To make nice loops on head or eye pins:

1. String selected beads on the head or eye pin.
2. Keep about $8 \mathrm{~mm}\left(1 / 3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ of wire. Cut off any extra.
3. Use round-nose pliers to grasp the wire just above the bead, at the arrow, and bend sharply away from you.
4. Now use small round nose pliers to grasp the tip of the wire, and bend it smoothly around the pliers down close to the beads.
