Suggested Materials:

6	#05-309-06-148	6mm Swarovski® rotunds, rose/ CosmoJet (Substitute #23-497-162, faceted rotund glass beads, fuchsia)
1	#05-309-08-148	8mm Swarovski rotund, rose/ CosmoJet (Substitute #23-498-162, faceted rotund glass bead, fuchsia)
12	#23-417-162	5x7mm faceted firepolish teardrop glass beads, fuchsia
2	#23-436-242	6mm faceted firepolish wheel glass beads, garnet
12	#23-443-162	3mm faceted firepolish round glass beads, fuchsia
2	#23-444-162	4mm faceted firepolish round glass beads, fuchsia
2 coils	#61-647-3-N	Necklace memory wire, silver plated
2	#41-280-1	Cone ends for memory wire, white
16	#24-980-04	4mm round SmartBead with BPS™, sterling silver

Tools: Heavy-duty flush cutters, glue

To make this design:

1. Cut your memory wire so that you have approximately two coils to work with.

TIP: Always cut memory wire with flush cutters that are designed for harder metals. Cutting memory wire will ruin smaller side cutters.

2. Add beads in the order shown, making sure to use the SmartBeads to place your beads in a symmetrical pattern. Each end takes two Smartbeads and a cone end.

NOTE: SmartBeads need no gluing or crimping to be held in place. They are created with a bead positioning system (BPS™) that holds the bead in position wherever you want it to stay.

3. Secure your cone-end with glue.
