Suggested Materials:

1 pair	34-063-06	Niobium French hook ear wires, yellow
2	29-842-2	25mm bone feather pendants, antiqued
2	82-920-001-62	11mm nylon covered stretchy rings, dark brown
12	37-145-6	6mm round jump rings, antiqued brass
Bracelets		
48	82-920-001-62	11mm nylon covered stretchy rings, dark brown
122	37-145-6	6mm round jump rings, antiqued brass
1	44-632-0	13x11mm flower charm, brass
1	44-616-0	9x7mm ladybug charm, brass
1	44-642-0	10x11mm bird charm, brass
3	29-842-2	25mm bone feather pendants, antiqued

Tools: flat-nose pliers

To make these designs:

1. Attach nylon covered stretchy rings with jump rings as pictured. (See jump-ring hint on the back side.)
2. Use jump rings to attach feathers, ear wires and other charms.

TIP: To antique yellow niobium ear wire, paint with Black Sharpie® marker and rub off.

NOTE: 16 nylon covered stretchy rings and 38 6mm round jump rings are used to make each 7" bracelet. Use more of each for a larger size.



Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of “ovalling” them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.
