Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	39-599-04	2-leaf hook and eye clasp, sterling silver
2	41-551-22	4x8mm crimp tubes with loop, sterling silver
2	37-295-440	4mm round jump rings, sterling silver
1	37-295-450	5mm round jump ring, sterling silver
16"	61-501-03	1mm genuine leather cord, dark brown
1		Artisan-made Art Clay™ Silver (ACS) bird pendant *
1		Artisan-made ACS 2-hole branch connector *

Tools: scissors, chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Add a 5mm jump ring to the ACS bird pendant and slide onto a 16" piece of 1mm leather cord.
2. Center the pendant on the cord and slide the cords through the holes on the ACS branch connector.
3. Add crimp tubes to the ends of the cords, secure with pliers.
4. Attach to the clasp with jump rings.

Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of “ovalling” them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.



Twist ends away from each other



Don't pull apart sideways
