

# "Harvest Moon" Necklace

## Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
3	29-851-32-R	32mm horn rings, red
1	21-644-006	40mm gemstone donut, carnelian
8	21-001-006-01	6mm round large-hole gemstone beads, carnelian
11	21-001-004-01	6mm round large-hole gemstone beads, black onyx
1	41-530-09	24x7x9mm wavy donut bail, sterling silver
36"	61-500-02	0.5mm leather cord, black

**Tools:** scissors

## To make this design:

1. Cut three 12" pieces of 0.5mm leather cord.
2. Using a lark's-head knot, attach one 12" piece of cord, to a horn ring.
3. Tie another horn ring to the other end and secure with double overhand knot.

4. Repeat step 2 with the second piece of 12" cord.
5. At the other end of this cord, make a large loop around the first cord end, and secure with an overhand knot.
6. Add the bail to the gemstone donut.
7. Center this donut bail pendant on the third 12" piece of cord.
8. Tie an overhand knot on each side of the bail to secure the pendant in place.
9. Tie two overhand knots about 1" from the center on each side.
10. Add large-hole beads as pictured, and tie another overhand knot.
11. Attach each end of pendant and bead cord to the horn donuts as pictured, again with lark's head knots. Make sure to leave enough cord to create the horizontal beaded section.
12. From opposite directions, string both remaining cords through the last group of large-hole beads. Secure each side of the beads with a sliding knot.

#### How to Make an Overhand Knot:

1. Make a loop with the cording.
2. Pass the cord that's behind the loop over the front cord and through the loop.
3. Pull to tighten.



#### How to Make a Lark's-Head Knot:

To create a lark's-head knot: fold stringing material in half, bend the fold over the ring or opening you are attaching to, then thread both ends through the loop created at the fold. (Illustration below shows attachment to a large jump ring)



#### How to Make Sliding Knot:

A sliding knot is a way to connect the two ends of cord together to make an adjustable length necklace.

1. Overlap the ends of the cord, and make a loop over the straight piece of cord from the opposite end. Do this to both sides.
2. Make a second loop on each side.
3. Pull the cord ends through each loop.
4. Pull tight.
