Suggested Materials:

29"	40-099-33-7	Hammered oval cable chain, antiqued copper
150"	40-099-13-0	2.1mm cable chain, raw brass
1	04-737-30-150	30mm Swarovski® crystal cosmic triangle, crystal/golden shadow
1	04-737-20-157	20mm Swarovski crystal cosmic triangle, crystal/copper
5	06-010-11-150	11mm Swarovski crystal round briolettes, crystal/golden shadow
7	37-136-6	5mm round jump rings, antiqued brass
1	39-240-7	6x10x4mm lobster clasp, antiqued copper

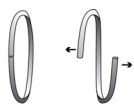
Tools: flush cutters, flat-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Cut a 29" piece of the hammered oval chain (41 links).
2. Cut an opening on each end link – so that it acts link a jump ring – and add a crystal triangle to each end link.
3. Attach five 30" pieces of cable chain to a jump ring, and attach the lobster clasp using another jump ring.
4. Attach this grouping of 5 chains to one end link of the oval chain.
5. Weave these 5 pieces of chain as a group through the links of the oval chain.
6. Use jump rings to attach the crystal briolettes to the ends of the chain, once the weaving is complete.

Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of "ovalling" them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.
