

“Peppermint Pattie” Bracelet

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Suggested Materials:

1 pkg.	61-167	2.5" large bracelet Remembrance™ memory wire, stainless steel
2	48-215-1	5-loop spacer bars, white
10	41-283-3	3mm memory wire end caps, silver plate
16	27-574-3	4mm round metal beads, silver plate
37	27-573-3	3mm round metal beads, silver plate
1 pkg	05-301-04-903	4mm Swarovski® Crystal Jams assortment™, I Knew the Bride
13	26-455-1	4.8mm fluted metal hogan beads, white
24	21-886-009	6mm round gemstone beads, moss agate



Tools: heavy-duty flush cutters (#65-507), Bead Stoppers™ (#69-144-06), Tenax™ Plus Super Glue adhesive (#60-240)

To make this design:

1. Cut 5 pieces memory wire, roughly one loop each.
2. Add a dab of adhesive to one end of each loop and add a memory wire end. Let dry.
3. Add 1 4mm metal bead each to 3 of the 5 wires, and a 4mm and 3mm metal bead to each of the remaining wires.
4. Thread all 5 wires through a spacer bar, alternating between the 1 & 2 bead wires.
5. Add crystals, gemstones and metal beads to all 5 wires, as pictured, or in any order you like.
6. Temporarily secure each end with a bead stopper as you proceed.
7. Add the second spacer bar, and repeat step 3 with the metal beads.
8. Glue the memory wire ends as in step 2.

NOTE: When adding the final spacer bar, you can insert the end of the closest strand into the farthest spacer-bar hole, so it lays diagonally across the top of the other strands.

TIP: Use heavy-duty flush cutters to cut the memory wire, to avoid gouging the cutting surface of the cutters.
