Suggested Materials:

54"	61-551-03	1mm genuine leather cord, dark brown
3	44-050-87-33	Karen Hill Tribe flower drop charm pendants, .999 fine silver
3	41-541	Tube-style bails, sterling silver
5	24-731-714	4.4x3.5mm Bali round beads with collar, sterling silver
10	24-992-33	3x3mm bamboo-shaped tube beads, sterling silver
5	37-295-450	5mm round jump rings, sterling silver
2	48-571-3	3mm fancy square cord ends with loop, sterling silver
1	39-553-D	Karen Hill Tribe hexagon toggle clasp, .999 fine silver

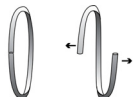
Tools: scissors, flat-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Cut three 18" pieces of cord and add beads and bails as pictured.
2. Use jump rings to attach the flower drop pendants to the bails, and the toggle clasp to the cord ends.
3. Slide all three ends of cord into the cord ends and gently flatten.

Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of "ovalling" them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.



Twist ends away from each other



Don't pull apart sideways
