Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	#51-700-213-8	Amate Studios™ adjustable 21mm square bezel finger ring, copper
1	#28-684-254	Tiny 3-D ceramic clown bead, blue/red
1	#49-953-01-C	Letter “C” metal charm with loop, red bronze
1	#82-500-08	8oz EasyCast epoxy resin kit
1		Family photo or copyright-free image, cut to size



Tools and supplies:

cutters (#69-056)
EcoGlue™ adhesive (#60-288) or Mod Podge®
resin mixing cups (#82-597)
stir sticks (#82-595)
cardboard box lid

TIPS:

- Cut the loop off of the letter charm.
- Seal the front and back of the image with EcoGlue or Mod Podge to prevent the image from bleeding.
- To prevent it from floating, glue the image to the bottom of the bezel cup. Allow the glue to dry thoroughly prior to adding resin.
- Create a level surface for the resin to cure in the ring. Turn a cardboard box over and poke holes in the lid with a pen or other sharp object.
