This design is made with CRYSTALLIZED™ – Swarovski Elements.



Suggested Materials:

1	51-516-07	7-loop cuff-style bracelet, sterling silver
21	05-000-06-183	CRYSTALLIZED™ 6mm faceted round beads, dark indigo
18	05-000-06-01	CRYSTALLIZED™ 6mm faceted round beads, crystal
21	05-301-06-52	CRYSTALLIZED™ 6mm faceted bicone beads, indian sapphire
26	05-810-06-204	CRYSTALLIZED™ 6mm crystal pearls, tahitian look
42	20-636-09-011	6mm freshwater faceted potato pearls, white
34	23-397-044	7mm Czech glass flower bead caps, crystal matte
68	43-110-3	Small filigree bead caps, silver plate
48	37-422-3	2" standard head pins, silver plate
20	37-145-3	6mm round jump rings, silver plate

Tools: flush cutters, chain-nose pliers, round-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Using standard wire-wrapping technique (shown below) make a minimum of 48 dangles, using crystals, pearls, glass and filigree bead caps. Be creative in their assembly.



TIP: Making all of your dangles first (before attaching any to the bracelet cuff) will help you better visualize how to attractively fit them together.

2. Once all individual dangles are created, attach 4-7 dangles to each of the jump rings to form a bundle.
3. Starting at one end of the bracelet, attach one bundle to the first loop on the cuff bracelet. Repeat this step until you've added 1-2 bundles of dangles to each of the 7 loops on the bracelet.

TIP: Work from one end of the bracelet to the other instead of skipping back and forth. This allows for one side of the next bracelet loop to always be easily accessible.

4. Once you've attached all 48 dangles, decide if the bracelet is as filled-out as you desire. If not, then make additional dangles and attach them where they work best to fill out the design.
