

"Engaged" Bracelet

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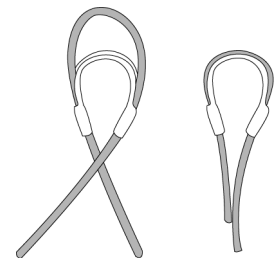
Suggested Materials:

1	48-830-25-02	Leather cuff end, 5 hole, black
16"	61-728-49-21	49-strand Beadalon®, silver plated
4	41-253-3	Crimp beads, silver plated
4	48-583	Crimp covers, sterling silver
4	41-045	Wire protectors, sterling silver
18	37-507	Head pins, 1", sterling silver
15	37-291-58	Jump rings, 4.5mm, Argentium® sterling silver
16	20-642-01-151	12mm coin pearls, pink
24 rings	40-099-27-3	Flat ring footage chain, silver plated
11	05-301-04-17	4mm Swarovski® faceted rondelles, light rose
4	05-301-04-138	4mm Swarovski faceted rondelles, rosaline
12	05-301-04-SE	4mm Swarovski faceted bicones, light rose satin
3	05-301-04-133	4mm Swarovski faceted bicones, padparadscha
3	05-301-04-13	4mm Swarovski faceted bicones, fuchsia

Tools: Round-nose pliers, wire cutters, scissors

To make this design:

- Slide the following crystal beads onto head pins and make wrapped loops in the following quantities (then set aside until step 13):
 - light rose – 2
 - rosaline – 4
 - light rose satin – 6
 - padparadscha – 3
 - fuchsia – 3
- Cut a 16" length of Beadalon.
- Fold the Beadalon in half and cut it again, making two 8" strands.
- String one of your Beadalon strands through a wire protector (see illustration), leaving about 1" on one side and 7" on the other.
- Insert the wire protector into the second hole on one of the leather ends.
- String a crimp bead onto both loose ends of the Beadalon and crimp it in place, trimming the excess from the short end.
- String in the following pattern: pearl, light rose, pearl, light rose satin, pearl, light rose, pearl, light rose satin, pearl, light rose, pearl, light rose satin, pearl, light rose, pearl, crimp bead.
- String the loose end of Beadalon through a wire protector.
- Insert the wire protector into the corresponding hole on the other leather cuff end and pass the loose end through the crimp bead.
- Pull tight and crimp.
- Repeat steps 4 through 10 for the second pearl strand.
- Cut chain into 12 sections with two links and a connector in each section.
- Reconnect the sections using jump rings, sliding two of your looped head pins with crystals onto the jump ring before closing.
- Connect each end of the chain to the leather ends using jump rings.



Tip: Leather cuff ends may need to be trimmed to fit wire protectors and jump rings.
