Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
4	#44-080-01	Gold-filled plaque connector
2	#44-050-75-95	Gold-filled 38mm triangle link
2	#44-050-75-93	Gold-filled 24mm triangle link
2	#44-050-75-92	Gold-filled 16mm triangle link
2	#31-634	Gold-filled 4mm ball post with loop
2	#37-390-46	Gold-filled 3.6mm round jump ring
2	#33-614	Gold-filled butterfly nuts

Tools: Chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. First, hang one connector plaque from the drop loop on the ball post earring.
2. Use a jump ring to hang another connector plaque and three triangles from the first connector link.

TIP: You can vary the design and pattern of these earrings by using connector links and jump rings to attach each triangle to another.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the second earring.
