1	40-412-3	7.5-8.5" curb chain bracelet, silver plate
5	23-234-000	4mm Czech glass disk spacers, assorted (use 3 red, 2 black)
5	37-422-3	2" standard head pins, silver plate
7	37-136-3	5mm round jump rings, silver plate
1	44-956	3-D cherub with horn charm, antiqued pewter
1	49-947-22-AS	Two-sided spiral-heart charm, antiqued silver plate
1	49-824	One-sided 12x14mm heart charm, antiqued pewter
1	49-944-25	3-D heart-in-hand charm, antiqued silver
1	49-944-38	3-D cast angel atop heart charm, antiqued silver
1	49-947-74-1	12x14mm TierraCast® Hammertone heart link, white
1	44-454-1	12x8mm heart lock charm, white
1	44-455-1	17x7mm key charm, white
1	44-465-1	12x9mm rose charm, white
1	44-468-1	8x8mm open heart charm, white

Tools and supplies: cutters, flat-nose pliers, round-nose pliers

TIP: The open heart, rose, key and heart lock charms are attached to the bracelet on a single jump ring.
