Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	#20-002-3221	Bead Cocktail™, Appletini
3	#05-020-06-02	Swarovski® Austrian crystal helix beads, crystal AB
1	#55-430-AP	Floral bookmark
1	#49-942-02-AP	Rose 2-loop connector
3	#37-421-1	Standard head pins
2	#37-136-1	Jump rings

Tools: Round-nose pliers, chain-nose pliers, cutters

To make this design:

1. Attach a jump ring to the loop of the bookmark. Add the rose connector to the jump ring, and close. Add a second jump ring to the bottom loop of your rose connector.
2. Using the pattern shown, create the flower ‘stems’ by adding beads to three head pins.
3. After you are satisfied with your pattern, use your round-nose pliers to create a loop-end on your head pin.
4. Trim excess wire, and attach the head-pin loop to your flower connector jump ring.
5. Repeat steps 2 through 4 for the remaining two ‘flower stems’ being careful to adjust the length of each, according to your tastes.
