Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
17	#21-000-167-39	Glass nugget gemstones, opalized "quartz"
16	#20-693-07-011	Wire-hole pearls, white
1	#39-550-S	Three-ring toggle clasp, sterling silver
2	#41-559	Sterling silver crimp tubes
	#61-905	49-strand Beadalon®

Tools:

Crimping pliers, chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Begin by cutting an 18" length of Beadalon.
2. Add a crimp tube to one end of the Beadalon, loop a small portion of Beadalon through the eye of the bar end of your clasp and back through the crimp tube. Use your crimping pliers to crimp the tube closed. Refer to www.aboutjewelry.com or www.michaels.com for crimping instructions.
3. String beads starting with a quartz nugget, and alternating with a pearl, until you have strung 17 nuggets and 16 pearls.
4. Repeat step number 2 for the remaining section of your clasp. Make sure you've pulled the excess Beadalon through the crimp tube before crimping.
