

“Remembering Lisa” Watch

As seen in the 2009 Summer Supplement



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This design is made with CRYSTALLIZED™ – Swarovski Elements.

Suggested Materials:

Tools and supplies: flush cutters, chain-nose pliers, round-nose pliers, adhesive such as Tenax™ Plus Super Glue (#60-240) or two-part epoxy (#60-230)

To make this design:

1. Use chain-nose pliers to remove the clasp from disc and loop bracelet.
2. Cut links from the bracelet if needed. The finished length of the watch is approximately 8".
3. Follow adhesive's instructions and, glue the crystal flower charms to the disks on the bracelet. Let dry.
4. Add the glass flower bead caps to the crystal head pins and make wrapped loops.
5. To each of five head pins, add a crystal pearl with a daisy spacer on each side, and make wrapped loops.
6. To each of four head pins, add a crystal pearl and rosebud bead, sandwiched between daisy spacers. Make wrapped loops.
7. Use jump rings to attach charms, locket, rhinestone drops and the dangles created in steps 2-4 to the oval loops on the bracelet, as shown, or in any pattern pleasing to the eye.
8. Connect the bracelet to one of the loops on the watch.
9. Attach lobster clasp to the other end with an 8mm jump ring.

To make nice wire-wrapped beaded head and eye pins:

(For best results, use both chain-nose and round-nose pliers.)

1. Use chain-nose pliers to grasp the wire just above the top of the bead.
2. Use your fingers to bend the wire sharply over the top of the pliers, at a 90° angle. You should have 2-3mm of straight wire between the bead and the bend (less for fine-gauge wire, more for heavy wire or more wraps).
3. Use round-nose pliers to grasp a spot just above the bend, and use your fingers to smoothly bend the wire all the way around the tip of the pliers. (For different sizes of loops, bend the wire around thinner or thicker portions of the pliers' tip.)
4. Now use pliers to grasp the wire firmly across the loop. Use your fingers or chain-nose pliers to carefully wrap the wire around the stem. For best control, experts recommend you break this step into a series of half wraps.
5. Trim excess with flush cutters.



Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of "ovalling" them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.
