**Tools and supplies:** scissors, cutters, bent-nose pliers, flat-nose pliers, round-nose pliers, chain-nose pliers, Crafters' Pick™ Jewel Bond adhesive (#60-281), assorted fibers and lace (available at local fabric, art, craft and hobby stores)
