

“Silver Plumeria” Earrings

As seen in the 2009 Spring Supplement



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Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock #</u>	<u>Name</u>
1 pr.	34-543-00	Horseshoe-shaped French hook ear wires, sterling silver
1pr.	42-500-03	13mm hoop findings with loop, sterling silver
2	37-295-250	5mm jump rings, sterling silver
2	24-928	Flower cup beads, sterling silver
2	03-700-06-02	6mm Swarovski crystal margarita sew-on stones, crystal/aurora borealis
2	05-301-03-183	3mm crystal bicones, indian pink
2	27-842-042-50	2mm oval Bead Bumpers™, clear



Tools: chain-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Gently open hoop findings and string a bicone, margarita, flower cup bead and Bead Bumper on each hoop, as pictured.
2. Attach hoops to ear wires with jump rings, making sure the flowers face forward.

TIP: The Bead Bumpers™ are optional, but they are a nice touch as they keep the beads in place on the hoops. Use another pair as French wire keepers to help keep the earrings on the ear!

Jump-ring hint:

When you open and close jump rings, twist sideways instead of “ovalling” them. This keeps their shape better, which makes them easier to close all the way.
