### Suggested Materials:

10	#20-465-L	23-28mm Tibetan-style oval beads, Chinese turquoise
10	#20-416-2	6x9mm nugget beads, Chinese turquoise
6	#24-731-745	Bali corrugated rondelle beads, sterling silver (limited to stock on hand)
1	#26-599-31	28mm Karen Hill Tribe flat/indented diamond-shaped bead, .999 fine silver
2	#26-599-32	25mm Karen Hill Tribe flat indented triangle-shaped beads, .999 fine silver (limited to stock on hand)
2	#26-599-34	22mm Karen Hill Tribe flat indented round beads, .999 fine silver
2	#41-554	Size1 crimp tubes, sterling silver
20"	#61-773-49-87	0.019" 49-strand Soft Flex® stringing cable, steel
1	#39-553-E	Karen Hill Tribe twisted-diamond toggle clasp, .999 fine silver

### Tools and supplies:

nippers (#65-700)  
chain-nose pliers (#69-271-03)  
bead reamer (#69-058)
