
"Solid Gold Dancing" Bracelet

Suggested Materials:

<u>Qiy.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
1	#39-418-4	Magnetic clasp, gold plated
2	#24-969-120-0	Curved gold-filled tube beads
1'	#64-627-12	20 gauge gold-filled round wire
6	#24-999-03	3mm gold-filled round bead
4	#24-999-04	4mm gold-filled round bead
2	#24-999-05	5mm gold-filled round bead
2	#28-334-25	Handmade lampwork tube beads, topaz/gold-foil
1	#28-334-10	Handmade lampwork rectangle beads, olive/black/gold-foil

Tools: Round-nose pliers, chain-nose pliers, flush cutters

To make this design:

- 1. Create a wrapped loop at one end of the wire, to attach one half of your clasp (see Figure 1).
- 2. Slide beads onto the wire in the following order: 3mm, 4mm, 5mm, curved tube, 3mm, gold foil, 4mm, green foil, 4mm, gold foil, 3mm, curved tube, 3mm, 5mm, 4mm, 3mm.

TIP: Before creating the final coil end of the bracelet, check the fit and make sure it rests loosely around your wrist.

3. Finish the end by creating another wrapped loop (see figure 1), and attaching the remaining clasp end.
