Suggested Materials:

1	#88-106-16-0	49mm Vintaj® ornate wreath filigree, natural brass
1	#88-106-02-0	42mm Vintaj passion flower petal filigree, natural brass
1	#88-103-10-0	9x39mm Vintaj scrollwork charm, natural brass
1 pkg	#55-000-08	Tim Holtz® Idea-ology™ foliage, antiqued metals (use 1 petal flower and 1 long fastener)
1 pkg	#55-000-16	Tim Holtz Idea-ology timepieces, antiqued metals (use smallest clock face)
1 pkg	#55-000-17	Tim Holtz Idea-ology washers, antiqued metals (use 1 washer)
1	#06-010-11-157	SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS 11mm crystal round briolette, crystal copper
9	#37-145-6	6mm round jump rings, antiqued brass plate
1	#38-293-7	1" round mesh-front bar pin, antiqued copper plate
6"	#40-099-17-7	2.9mm flat link chain with figure-8 connectors, antiqued copper plate
6"	#40-099-16-7	2.1mm drawn flattened cable chain, antiqued copper plate (cut one 4½" and two ¾" pieces)
12"	#46-404-30	24-gauge Artistic Wire®, gunmetal

Tools and supplies:

Bead Fix™ adhesive (#60-242), 2-hole metal punch (#69-235), Wubbers™ chain-nose pliers (#69-275-03), Wubbers flat-nose pliers (#69-275-30), Eurotool® 5" side flush cutters (#69-056), 0000 steel wool, Tim Holtz Adirondack® Alcohol Inks (lettuce, cranberry & eggplant)

TIPS:

- Color the filigrees and flower with alcohol inks. Once dry, brush with steel wool to remove some ink to obtain the desired effect.
- Attach the filigrees to bar pin with a 6" piece of 24-gauge wire.
- Punch 1 hole on each side of the center hole on the clock face. Attach the metal flower and a washer to the clock face through the center hole with the long fastener. The washer allows the flower to spin.
- Use another 6" piece of wire to attach the clock face to the filigrees through the two holes just punched and secure with adhesive.
- Use jump rings to attach the crystal, scrollwork charm and chain to the filigree.
