

“Steel Wheels” Bracelet

Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
1 roll	#40-099-18-1	Rollo (aka belcher) footage chain, white
8	#37-187-1	Jumbo jump rings, white
1	#39-188-AP	Antiqued pewter cast snake toggle clasp

Tools: Heavy-duty pliers, flush cutters

To make this design:

1. Cut three lengths of chain, 20 links long (or 2.5”).
2. Cut two more lengths of chain, 8 links long (or 1.25”).
3. Using heavy-duty pliers, open your jump rings to connect your chain.
Using the image on this page as a guide, connect a large ring to both ends of your longer chain pieces.
4. Connect two more large rings to each end, adding your short chain pieces to the last ring.
5. Add a final large ring to the end of your short chain pieces, and attach toggle clasp ends.

TIP: Adjust the length to your personal taste by adding or removing links in the short chain.
