1	50-338	18" round omega chain necklace, sterling silver
1	24-731-751	14x48mm pierced curved-tube bead with collar, sterling silver
2	28-356-02-003	15mm metal-core lampwork glass flower Calypso™ beads with large sterling silver-lined hole, red/white
2	26-505	6x5mm large-hole rotund spacer beads, sterling silver

1	51-515-M	Medium size changeable-bead cuff-style bracelet, sterling silver
2	28-356-02-001	15mm metal-core lampwork glass flower Calypso beads with large sterling silver-lined hole, black/white
1	28-356-02-003	15mm metal-core lampwork glass flower Calypso bead with large sterling silver-lined hole, red/white
3	26-505	6x5mm large-hole rotund spacer beads, sterling silver
4	23-286-021	6x4mm large-hole glass roller beads, black
Stretch Bracelet		
3	61-459	7" bangle bracelet springs, stainless steel
2	05-041-18-160	18mm Swarovski® crystal puffed rondelle beads, crystal/ silver shade
1	28-356-02-001	15mm metal-core lampwork glass flower Calypso bead with large sterling silver-lined hole, black/white
3	26-505	6x5mm large-hole rotund spacer beads, sterling silver

Tools: no tools required

To make these designs:

The chains and bracelet forms are easy to use. The large-hole beads just slide on!

Necklace

1. Unhook the necklace clasp and string the beads as pictured.

Cuff Bracelet

1. Unscrew the threaded ball at one end of the bracelet.
2. String beads as pictured, and screw on threaded ball.

Stretch Bracelet

1. String beads as pictured, onto all 3 of the stretchy spring bracelets, and screw bracelet ends together.

TIP: Before screwing the ends together, “backspin” a few times to keep the spring from twisting in a “figure 8” after it is closed.
