Suggested Materials:

<u>Qty.</u>	<u>Stock</u>	<u>Name</u>
18"	#61-647-3-A	Remembrance™ memory wire, large bracelet size
1	#08-801150-01	Swarovski® crystal prism, twisted-oval shape
1	#41-232-1	No-loop prong bail
12	#37-722-3	Standard eye pins, silver plated
1pkg	#20-002-3211	TOHO® seed bead Cocktail™, greyhound
1pkg	#49-939-AP	"Twelve Days of Christmas" charms, antiqued pewter

Tools: Heavy-duty flush cutters (such as product #65-507), round-nose pliers

To make this design:

1. Cut about 18" of memory wire (approximately two full coils). Make loop at end.
2. Attach the prong bail to the prism. Attach bail to memory wire loop.

TIP: Memory wire is a very tough stainless steel wire. To preserve your beading tools, manipulate and cut this wire using heavy duty tools only.

3. Add beads from the TOHO cocktail to wire in random order, leaving 1".
4. Continue until the wire is covered with beads. Create a loop at the top.
5. Add each charm to the loop of an eye pin (12 total).
6. Add a black seed bead, a tube bead, two tiny seed beads (in any color) and another tube bead. Repeat for all 12.
7. Finish by looping the top of the eye pin, leaving the top loop open enough to attach to the hanging.
8. Starting at the top, add each charm, spaced approx. 1" apart. Use pictures and text below as a guide
