8	05-328-04-191	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm faceted XILION bicone crystals, cyclamen opal
8	05-328-05-191	CRYSTALLIZED™ 5mm faceted XILION bicone crystals, cyclamen opal
1	05-328-06-191	CRYSTALLIZED™ 65mm faceted XILION bicone crystal, cyclamen opal
8	05-328-04-189	CRYSTALLIZED™ 4mm faceted XILION bicone crystals, greige
6	05-328-05-189	CRYSTALLIZED™ 5mm faceted XILION bicone crystals, greige
2	05-328-06-189	CRYSTALLIZED™ 6mm faceted XILION bicone crystals, greige
19"	61-514-09	Griffin® Size 4 silk bead cord with needle end, amethyst
2"	41-071-3	1.1mm medium French wire (bullion), silver plate (two 1" pieces)
1	39-554	Heart toggle clasp, sterling silver
2	48-583	3mm crimp covers, sterling silver

Tools and supplies: round-nose pliers, scissors, clothes iron, Tri-Cord™ knotter (#65-950), Bead Fix™ adhesive (#60-242)

TIPS:

- To remove the creases caused by the cardboard packaging, iron the silk cord before using.
- Add a drop of adhesive on each knot under the crimp cover.
- Knotting can be done by hand or with a cord knotter. The key to good knotting is to make sure the knot is as close to the beads as possible, so the beads don't move.
